HOLIDAY CABARET

Lead Vocalists – Soloists, Duets, Trios (All Ages):

- Seeking versatile and dynamic performers with exceptional vocal abilities. Prepare a 32 bar song that showcases your vocal range and stage presence. If you wish to perform a song from a NEW musical on Broadway, we ask that you prepare that song and provide an INSTRUMENTAL vocal track to sing along with.

PANTO

We are casting the following characters from our Snow White and the Merry Elves.

Snow White: Sweet, kind, and filled with Christmas spirit. She loves helping others and is eager to spread joy at Christmas.

The Evil Queen: Still jealous of Snow White, but now her goal is to ruin Christmas because she believes she's the most important person in the kingdom, not Santa!

Santa Claus: makes a brief but heroic appearance to thank Snow White and the Merry Elves for saving Christmas.

Seven Merry Elves: Santa's playful, cheeky helpers who double as the dwarfs. Each has a unique personality, and they love Christmas..

Tinsel – Enthusiastic and a bit clumsy, always getting tangled in decorations.

Jingle – Loves music and always has bells jingling somewhere on their outfit.

Spark – Full of energy and often causing minor chaos with their enthusiasm.

Twinkle – A bit forgetful but very cheerful, always trying to brighten the mood.

Glitter – Creative and artistic, but often makes a glittery mess.

Frost – Cool-headed and logical, often trying to keep the others organized.

Spruce – Practical and down-to-earth, usually in charge of the heavier tasks like carrying trees or presents.

Naughty, The Elf: The Queen's partner in crime, always messing things up. Eventually, this Elf turns good after learning about the true meaning of Christmas.

AUDITION SIDES

EVIL QUEEN, NAUGHTY

Evil Queen: *(In a low, dramatic voice)* Ahhh, look at this... Christmas cheer spreading like a plague throughout my forest. That wretched Snow White dares to fill this place with joy and kindness. But not for long...*(She steps forward, sneering at the audience, as if they are part of the problem.)* Do you think you can enjoy Christmas this year? Do you?! *(Encouraging the audience to respond. If they shout "Yes!" she reacts with a wicked laugh)* HA! We'll see about that! I have a plan—a plan so devious, so wicked, it will ruin Christmas forever! *(Naughty jumps forward, clapping excitedly, rubbing his hands together in anticipation)*

Naughty: Ooooh, tell them, tell them the plan, your nastiness! They won't be so jolly once they hear it! *(Naughty giggles mischievously, glancing at the audience with a cheeky smirk)*

Evil Queen: Oh, they won't be cheering much longer, will they, Naughty? For you see, I have found a way to steal the very heart of Christmas. All the magic, all the joy, all the wonder—it will be mine! *(She pauses, looking at the audience dramatically then evil laugh)* And do you know how I'm going to do it? By stopping that goody-two-shoes Snow White from spreading her ridiculous cheer.*(The audience is encouraged to boo at this point, reacting strongly to the Queen's evil plan)*

Naughty: *(Covering his ears)* Eeee! I don't like that sound. Booing? Really? They're booing us, your evilness!

Evil Queen: *(Laughing wickedly)* Let them boo! It only shows how weak they are, depending on Snow White to save them. But I have a secret weapon—a Christmas spell so powerful, it will make everyone forget about Christmas forever! *(She waves her hand dramatically, as if casting a spell over the audience. Naughty hops excitedly beside her)*

Naughty: Yes, yes! I love it! No presents, no decorations, no jolly laughter, no Santa—just boring, miserable days with no Christmas in sight!

SNOW WHITE, MERRY ELVES

Jingle, Spark, Twinkle, Tinsel, Spruce, Glitter, Frost

Snow White: Oh dear, I don't know what that strange wind was earlier... But I have to find out what's happening. Maybe someone in the forest can help me! *(She looks*

around, hearing the sounds of chaos and frantic chatter) What's that noise? bells jingling, and—(Before she can finish, one of the elves, **Tinsel**, bursts dragging a huge roll of wrapping paper, completely oblivious to Snow White. **Jingle, Spark, Twinkle, Glitter, Frost, and Spruce**, all follow, in various sta



Jingle: I've lost the scissors again!

Spark: I have a bow stuck on my...*(stuck on butt and spins around trying to take it off)*

Twinkle: This present is too big! It won't fit in any box!

(Snow White watches them for a moment, bewildered, before stepping forward)

Snow White: Excuse me... are you—are you Santa's elves? *(The elves freeze for a moment, then turn to her in unison, startled. There's a comical beat of silence)*

Tinsel: Santa's *helpers*—well, we try, at least!

Spruce: We're the Seven Merry Elves, and we've got a LOT of work to do! *(The elves all start talking at once, rushing around again in a flurry of chaos. Snow White can't help but giggle at the sight)*

Snow White: Oh my! It looks like you could use some help. What are you doing?

Glitter: We're getting everything ready for Santa's big night! But it's—*(The elves all shout in unison)*

Seven Elves: CHAOS!

Snow White: Chaos? But why?

Frost: Because there's so much to do, and everything's going wrong!

(The elves all start frantically running around again, trying to fix their mess. Snow White laughs and claps her hands.)

Snow White: Well, how about a song to keep your spirits up? I'm sure everything will turn out alright.

Jingle: A song? Oh, we do love songs! Especially one about our chaos!

Tinsel: Yeah, let's sing about the madness!
